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
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

Inspired first by aesthetic color palettes, Catherine Marion creates fully immersive, bespoke atmospheres in her flowers,




Through inspired combinations of historical portraits and found objects, Whitfield Lovell's *Kin* series envisions the kinds of personal and ancestral histories lost to many African Americans, including the artist himself. To create each piece, Lovell begins with a photorealistic drawing of an anonymous person, deriving his sources from postcards and cabinet cards, tintypes and bubble-glass portraits, most of them created between the Emancipation Proclamation and the Civil Rights Movement. With the addition of reclaimed objects, Lovell imagines the personality and interests each of his subjects might have had—making both his art and the model three-dimensional. Kindling memories both personal and collective, each of the works featured in this calendar tells a story.





Tamara Madden was a Jamaican-born, American-raised, mixed-media artist and professor of art and visual culture at Spelman College in Atlanta. Taking inspiration from her homeland, Gustav Klimt, and Milwaukee artist Ras 'Ammar Nsoroma—among others—Madden often depicted powerful Black women of the African diaspora, royal and draped in elaborate headdresses and lavish ensembles. Madden struggled most of her adult life with chronic health issues, and turned to art for a semblance of normalcy and relief. She died in 2017 at the age of 42, but her work lives on to represent her strength and unique point of view. The images in this calendar offer a window into her inspiring life and legacy.



John A. Ruthven, the celebrated artist and conservationist often called the "20th-century Audubon," followed in the

footsteps of his legendary predecessor. After extensive research on his subjects, Ruthven created detailed sketches and meticulously rendered paintings. Whether in delicate watercolor or bold acrylics, the works in this calendar give a birder's view through the months of the year.




Charley Harper

A titan among Modern painters, Mark Rothko once said that the subject matter of his paintings was the extremes of human emotion. His extraordinary achievement was the communication of tragedy and elation through forms reduced to starkest simplicity oftentimes a pair of rectangles. Born Marcus Rothkowitz in a Latvian Jewish community, the artist emigrated to the United States at the age of ten. After a series of artistic metamorphoses, he established himself as a leader among New York's artistic avant-garde in the late 1940s. Rothko worked on large canvases, but he felt that the scale was intimate, establishing a close physical relationship with the viewer. Discover the power of Rothko's deceptively simply compositions in these two 2024 calendars.

In the images shown in this calendar, he depicts the majesty of California, Oregon, Arizona, New York, and beyond in dramatic patchworks that span the American coasts.



German Renaissance artist Albrecht Dürer is held up as perhaps the most significant artist of his time, particularly for his printmaking. Dürer created woodcuts and engravings that

revolutionized printmaking as a form of fine art. His technical brilliance grew, resulting in a trio of masterpieces: Knight, Death, and the Devil; Melencolia I; and Saint Jerome in His Study. Along with these three engravings, this calendar includes nine additional works each equally intense and fascinating.





Depicting his wife and children (all eight of them!), shoreside strolls, friends, neighbors, and evening rituals, these windows into the artist's life evoke a sense of calm and domesticity. Each of the images in this calendar was published in his splendidly wholesome series A Home, published between 1894 and 1897.
